This is a tool for you to search for courses that transfer from the community college to the University of Iowa. Brief Instructions for Transfer Tool:

- **Click on the link to the left** and use the drop-down boxes
- **Transfer Institution** = put in school where you want to take your courses
- **UI College** = College of Liberal Arts
- **Select the Curriculum Area of Courses** = put in whatever is marked "X" need on your transcript evaluation (i.e. Literary, Visual & Performing Arts,

International & Global Issues, Rhetoric, etc)

• Hit Search

The courses that appear will transfer to Iowa for that particular requirement. Repeat the process for each "need" on your transcript evaluation. **Do not select any "Career & Technical" or "Career Development" courses as they do not transfer.**
