Application Details:

Applications are submitted through Qualtrics (link below). You will be asked to provide a brief impact statement on how this funding will support your educational goals and a detailed budget outlining how the requested funding will be allocated. In addition, the table below describes the different requirements for each type of funding requested.

Research: materials, equipment, or participant incentive	Please describe your research project, including its objectives and methodology. Please limit your response to 250-500 words. Advisor letter of support required.
Conference Attendance: registration fees, travel, or accommodation for presenting research	Please provide detailed information about the conference you plan to attend, including the name of the conference, dates, and location. Additionally, share the title and a summary of the research you will be presenting. Please limit your response to 250-500 words. Documentation of accepted abstract required.
Publication Fees: Cost associated with publishing research	Provide information regarding the journal and publication fees for which you are requesting funding. Include the title of the publication you are submitting to. Please limit your response to 250-500 Words.
Workshops, external courses, or trainings	Describe the educational opportunity you plan to engage in. Include details such as the name, location, and how it will benefit your academic and professional development. Please limit your response to 250-500 words. Advisor letter of support required.

Criteria & Considerations:

- **Eligibility:** Students must be currently enrolled in the PhD program at the time funding is utilized.
- **Maximum Funding:** Students should be aware that the maximum funding available is up to approximately \$5,000 per student over the entire duration of their program. This amount is not guaranteed per student as each application will be reviewed independently. Funds can be used across different categories as needed, but students should plan their requests carefully to ensure they make the most of the available funds.
- **Application and Approval:** Students can apply for funding multiple times, All funding requests must be submitted and approved in advance. This ensures that funds are allocated appropriately. Applications requesting reimbursement will not be approved. Applications are accepted on a rolling basis. Decisions will be communicated within two weeks.
- **College of Nursing & University of Iowa Policy:** Requests and use of funds must align with University of Iowa and College of Nursing policies.
