

DAISY FACULTY AWARD

Criteria

Nominees for the DAISY Faculty Award must meet the following demonstrated criteria:

- A nurse educator who goes above and beyond expected teaching.
- Evidence of an educational leader.
- Evidence of a mentor and role model to students.
- Evidence of high-quality impact on the College of Nursing mission.
- Preference will be given to instructors and clinical track faculty.
- Nominees must be a College of Nursing educator for a minimum of 2 years.

Nomination Information

- Nominations can be initiated by current students, faculty, colleagues, department administrators, deans, or by self-nomination.

Required Nomination Documents

- Brief nomination letter that includes title of the award and description of how the candidate meets the award criteria.
- The most current CV on file for the nominee will be used unless otherwise provided by the nominee.
- Two letters of support; one from a student and the other may be from clinical site staff or peer colleagues addressing why this nominee should receive the Daisy Faculty Award.

Submission Information

- Nomination letters with multiple signatures will be accepted.
- Each award can only be won once every 5 years.
